Your App Completed - Submit your finished app

Overview

Turn in your finished App Inventor app.

You will also present your app to the class. See that assignment as well.

What you need to do

When you are finished with your app (testing, commenting, checking all parts):

1. Review one last time to make sure your app is finished. Be sure you have used good names for components. Remove any unneeded things in the Blocks Editor.
2. Add comments in the Blocks Editor to show special things you did. Also, add comments for things that don't quite work yet, or any other troubles you are having.
3. Make sure you have not made any accidental changes when you last worked on it. (Test it one last time to be sure)

How and What to turn in

After you are finished and have a fully working app, go to the App Inventor main page (the one that lists all your projects, click on My Projects to get there from the open project). Click the checkbox next to the assignment you want to turn in. Under More Actions, click Download source. Save the zip file to a place you can remember. Then go into Bb and submit the zip file in the assignment.

If you have multiple apps tied together with activity starter, save each as a separate .zip file saved from App Inventor. Save each separately into the Bb assignment, then do one submit.

Mac Users: follow the special steps carefully. Use the seven steps!

If you want to have your app posted on the class web page so others can find and use it, please indicate that in the comments section in Bb. Include both the normal .zip file and also a .apk file. Both will be posted with your name and app name. You can include a picture too if you want that added. Upload each separately, saving each time, all in the same Bb assignment (do multiple saves then do a submit).

Grading

50 points in Assignments for your complete project app. 30 points for the working features of the app. 10 points for the clarity, understandability, and style of your work in Designer and Block Editor. 10 points for good comments in the Blocks Editor.
