#### 1. Submit

A set of screen shots showing each of the items in Contents below. Include the screen shots in order listed **all in one file which can be .doc, .docx, .pdf.** Your file must open on the university computers. Include the file extension (e.g., .pdf) in the file name.

#### 3. Content
